On request of the Ld. Counsel for the appellant, it is further directed that the society shall accept the amount in two installments payable within a period of two months from the date of settlement. The appellant shall visit the office of the society on 12.07.2025 at 11:00AM and try to work out settlement.

Ld. Counsel further submits that the society be directed to withdraw the complaint u/s 138 of the NI Act on payment of the settled amount.

It goes without saying that in case the appellant pays up the loan amount, the 138 complaint cannot survive and society shall ensure that the same is withdrawn.

AR of the Society prays that necessary directions be issued to Asst. Collector Grade-I, office of RCS to waive off the surcharge of 5 % in Arbitration case no. 4033/AR/ARB/2023-24 titled as The Mahalaxmi Co-operative Urban Thrift & Credit Society Ltd. V/s. Sh. Sh. Netrapal & Ors.

The prayer for wavier of 5% Surcharge is allowed. A division Bench of the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in **W.P.(C)** 2836/2018 titled as Kaushalaya Devi &Ors. Vs. Delhi Nagrik Sehkari Bank Ltd., decided on 02.12.2021, has held that where the judgement debtor makes payment directly to the decree holder, no surcharge is to be paid to the office of RCS. Therefore, the amount, which has been paid out of Court, directly by the appellant to the respondent society is not liable to any surcharge.
