Appellant volunteered to pay an amount of Rs. 80,000/- over and above the CD and Share money of himself and his parents, i.e. Sh. S.K. Gupta (father) and Smt. Santosh Kumari (mother). However, Ld. Counsel for the society submits that he has instructions from the society to settle the matter at Rs. 2,40,000/- though the claim was Rs. 2,77,000/-.

Appellant submits that he is ready to pay an amount of Rs. 80,000/- and can deposit the same within a week from today.

In the aforesaid facts and circumstances, when appellant is willing to deposit Rs. 80,000/- within one week from today and roughly amount of Rs. 1,34,000/- towards CD and Share money of himself and his parents, is already lying with the respondent society, Tribunal is of the view that the amount should be sufficient to settle the dispute in view of the law laid down by the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in *Kamlesh Jain Vs. Jain Cooperative Bank Ltd.*, reported as 2007(142) DLT 782, wherein settlement with interest @ 10% has been accepted, Respondent society shall kept necessary instructions from the MC.

AR of the respondent society prays that necessary directions be issued to Asst. Collector Grade-I, office of RCS to waive off the surcharge of 5 % in arbitration case no. 962/AR/ARB/2023-24 titled as Jai Shree Agrasen Co-operative Urban Thrift & Credit Society Ltd. V/s. Sh. Neeraj Gupta & Ors.

Heard.

The prayer for waiver of 5% Surcharge is allowed. A division Bench of the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in *W.P.(C) 2836/2018 titled as Kaushalaya Devi & Ors. Vs. Delhi Nagrik Sehkari Bank Ltd., decided on 02.12.2021*, has held that where the judgment debtor makes payment directly to the decree holder, no surcharge is to be paid to the office of RCS. Therefore, the amount, which has been paid out of Court, directly by the appellant to the respondent society is not liable to any surcharge.

Appellant shall deposit amount of Rs. 80,000/- with the respondent society within one week from today. On deposit thereon, N.O.C shall be issued and submit before the Tribunal on the adjourned date.
