However, after deducting 5% surcharge, society has received Rs. 1,44,629/- plus roughly Rs. 20,000/- as CD & Share Money.

On behalf of the respondent society, it is submitted that no further recovery shall be affected from the Appellant and in case the entire loan amount is recovered from the LR of Principal Borrower, the amount recovered from the Appellant shall also be refunded to him.

In view of the statement made on behalf of the society, Appellant prays for the present appeal to be disposed off as not pressed with liberty to seek recovery from the LR of the deceased Principal Borrower i.e. Sh. Chander Bali Tiwari and alternatively to receive the amount from the society in case society is able to recover the amount from LR of Principal Borrower.
